On the A60 at Newstead Abbey Gates
If approaching from the **Nottingham** direction turn **Right**, and from the **Mansfield** direction turn **Left**, into **Longdale Lane**.

Take the first left turn into **Vernon Ave**, (do not take Sheepwalk Lane) and in a short distance turn **Left** at the T-junction into **Vernon Crescent**. The Village Hall will be found on the right.
